### BERMUDA MONETARY AUTHORITY (COMMEMORATIVE COIN SERIES) (BERMUDA FLOWERS) REGULATIONS 2018

BR 135 / 2018

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Bermuda Monetary Authority Act 1969 and on the recommendation of the Bermuda Monetary Authority, makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Bermuda Monetary Authority (Commemorative Coin Series) (Bermuda Flowers) Regulations 2018.

#### Interpretation

2 In these Regulations—

“Authority” means the Bermuda Monetary Authority; and

“commemorative coins” means the Bermuda Flowers Commemorative Coin Series to be issued under these Regulations.

#### Issue of the commemorative coins

3 The Authority may, in accordance with the specifications set out in these Regulations, issue the commemorative coins.

#### Denomination of commemorative coins

4 The denominations of the commemorative coins shall be as follows—

- (a) Coin 1 - one ounce silver (no colour) - \$2;
- (b) Coin 2 - one ounce silver (colour) - \$2;
- (c) Coin 3 - one-twentieth ounce gold - \$5;

- (d) Coin 4 - cupronickel (no colour) - \$0.25; and
- (e) Coin 5 - cupronickel (colour) - \$0.25.

Form and design

5 The form and design of the commemorative coins shall be in accordance with the sample coins deposited with the Authority and in particular—

- (a) the obverse design of every commemorative coin shall be the portrait by sculptor Ian Rank-Broadley of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II in profile, together with the inscriptions “BERMUDA”, “ELIZABETH II” and every commemorative coin shall respectively bear the years—
  - (i) “2019” (on the Bermudiana commemorative coin);
  - (ii) “2020” (on the Easter Lily commemorative coin);
  - (iii) “2021” (on the Hibiscus commemorative coin);
  - (iv) “2022” (on the Oleander commemorative coin);
  - (v) “2023” (on the Bird of Paradise commemorative coin); and
  - (vi) “2024” (on the Bermuda Yellow Buttercup commemorative coin);
- (b) the reverse design of every commemorative coin of the series shall respectively depict—
  - (i) a Bermudiana flower (*Sisyrinchium bermudiana*), on the Bermudiana commemorative coin;
  - (ii) an Easter Lily (*Lilium longiflorum*), on the Easter Lily commemorative coin;
  - (iii) a Hibiscus (*Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*), on the Hibiscus commemorative coin;
  - (iv) an Oleander flower (*Nerium oleander*), on the Oleander commemorative coin;
  - (v) a Bird of Paradise (*Strelitzia*), on the Bird of Paradise commemorative coin; and
  - (vi) a Bermuda Yellow Buttercup (*Oxalis pes-caprae*), on the Bermuda Yellow Buttercup commemorative coin;
- (c) the shape of every coin shall be round.

Standard weight and composition

6 The standard weight and composition of the commemorative coins, and the amount of tolerance and variation allowed therein shall be as set forth in the Schedule.
