The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1) of the Marine Board Act 1962, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 6) Notice 2018.

Christmas Boat Parade, St. George's Harbour

2 The Christmas Boat Parade ("the Parade") will be held in St. George's Harbour on Saturday 1 December 2018 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.

Closure of certain sections of St. George's Harbour

3 (1) The area of waters of St. George's Harbour, on a line between the eastern end of Pennos Wharf and Convict Bay to the St. David's shoreline on Ships Wharf, will be closed to normal marine traffic during the Parade.

(2) A five-knot no wake restriction will apply to all boats navigating within St. George's Harbour during the Parade.

### Postponement of Parade

4 In the event of inclement weather, the Parade will be held on Saturday 8 December 2018 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m., and the provisions of this Notice will apply in all respects to the Parade held on that date.

### Patrol of course

5 St. George's Harbour will be patrolled by marshal boats during the Parade, and all mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to exercise caution when approaching or navigating within St. George's Harbour during the Parade.

### Offence

6 It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 for the master of a ship or boat to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 112 of that Act.
