The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1) of the Marine Board Act 1962, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 7) Notice 2018.

Christmas Boat Parade, Hamilton Harbour

2 The Christmas Boat Parade ("the Parade") will be held in Hamilton Harbour on Saturday 8 December 2018 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.

Closure of certain areas of Hamilton Harbour

3 (1) The area of waters of Hamilton Harbour, on a line between Saltus Island and the eastern end of Hinson's Island to the Warwick shoreline at Godet's Passage, will be closed to normal marine traffic during the Parade.

(2) A five-knot no wake restriction will apply to all boats navigating within Hamilton Harbour during the Parade.

Postponement of Parade

4 In the event of inclement weather, the Parade will be held on Sunday 9 December 2018 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m., and the provisions of this Notice will apply in all respects during the Parade held on that date.

Patrol of course

5 Hamilton Harbour will be patrolled by marshal boats during the Parade, and all mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to exercise caution when approaching or navigating within Hamilton Harbour during the Parade.

Offence

6 It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 for the master of a ship or boat to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 112 of that Act.
