IN EXERCISE of the power conferred on
the Governor by section 6 of the Public
Holidays Act 1947 and acting in accordance
with the advice of the Cabinet, I do hereby
declare that Friday, the thirty-first day of May
two thousand and nineteen shall not be kept
as the Bermuda Day public holiday and that
Friday, the twenty-fourth day of May two
thousand and nineteen shall be kept as the
Bermuda Day public holiday in lieu.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal
of Bermuda this 19th day of December two
thousand and eighteen, in the sixty-seventh
year of Her Majesty's Reign.
