CUSTOMS TARIFF (APPROVED BUSINESSES) NOTICE 2019

BR 44 / 2019

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the power conferred by customs procedure code 4229 of the Fifth Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act 1970, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Approved Businesses) Notice 2019.

Interpretation

2 In this Notice, “customs procedure code” or “CPC” has the meaning given in section 1 of the Customs Tariff Act 1970.

Approved businesses

3 The following businesses listed in the first column are approved businesses under CPC 4229 of the Fifth Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act 1970 in respect of the qualifying goods in the corresponding second column—

(a)	Mason and Associates Ltd.	goods for the manufacture of protective exterior fabric panels for windows and doors
(b)	Island Potions Ltd.	goods for the manufacture and packaging of hair products
(c)	Bermuda Shutters Ltd.	goods for the manufacture of exterior shutters, doors, door frames and thresholds for doors

(d)	Felicia DeRoza trading as FRD Essentials	goods for the manufacture and packaging of cosmetic or toilet preparations and soap bearing the trade name "FRD Essentials"
(e)	Jennifer Rodrigues trading as Jennifer Rodrigues Designs	goods for the manufacture and packaging of jewellery bearing the trade name "Jewellery by Jennifer Rodrigues Designs"
(f)	Jeffrey & Sons Ltd.	goods for the manufacture of exterior rolling shutter systems
(g)	Jon Faulkner trading as Jon Faulker Gallery	goods for the manufacture and packaging of ceramic articles bearing the trade name "Jon Faulkner Gallery"
(h)	P.V.C. Windows and Doors Ltd.	goods for the manufacture of doors, windows, window frames and thresholds for doors, fencing, exterior shutters, railings and other builders' ware
(i)	Bermuda Clayworks Ltd.	materials and supplies for use to operate, equip, maintain, repair, and fit-out the facility; and for use to manufacture, package, label, and distribute pottery and ceramic products bearing the trademark "Bermuda Clayworks"
(j)	Crow Lane Bakery Ltd.	goods of heading 17.01 of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act 1970 (cane or beet sugar and chemically pure sucrose, in solid form)
(k)	Dunkley and Pioneer Dairies Limited	goods of heading 17.01 of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act 1970 (cane or beet sugar and chemically pure sucrose, in solid form)

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Approved businesses	Qualifying goods
(l) any business that holds a valid licence granted by the Chief Environmental Health Officer under the Public Health (Food) Regulations 1950 to operate— (i) a home victualling manufactory or bakery; or (ii) an itinerant restaurant with a stand that cannot be propelled or drawn	goods of heading 17.01 of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act 1970 (cane or beet sugar and chemically pure sucrose, in solid form)
