The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1)(a) and (b) of the Marine Board Act 1962, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 3) Notice 2019.

St. George's Marine Expo Boat Race

2 The St. George's Marine Expo Boat Race will take place on Sunday 19 May 2019 between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Course of Race

3 The Expo Boat Race will take place between Ordnance Island and Meyer's boat yard across the water to the two old navy markers on the southern side of St. George's Harbour.

Non-application of speed limit

4 The speed limit fixed by paragraph 2 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001 shall not apply to persons and boats participating in the race.

Patrol of St. George's Harbour

5 The area of St. George's Harbour referred to in paragraph 3 will be patrolled by the marine police and marshal boats, and all mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to exercise caution when approaching or navigating the area.

Offence

6 It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 for the master of any ship or boat to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 112 of that Act.

7 The Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 2) Notice 2019 (BR56/2019) is hereby revoked.
