The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1)(a) and (b) of the Marine Board Act 1962 and paragraph 4 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 4) Notice 2019.

Power Boat Closed Circuit Races

2 Power Boat Closed Circuit Races will be held at Ferry Reach between the hours of 12:00 noon and 5:00 p.m. on the following dates—

(a) Sunday 9 June 2019;

(b) Sunday 30 June 2019.

Patrol of race course

3 Ferry Reach will be patrolled by marshal boats, and all mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to—

- (a) exercise extreme caution when approaching Ferry Reach; and
- (b) follow all lawful directions given by the marshals during the races.

Non-application of speed limits

4 The speed limits fixed by paragraph 3 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001 shall not apply to persons participating in the races.

Offence

5 (1) It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 for the master of a ship or boat to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 112 of that Act.

(2) In this Notice "boat" includes a personal water craft, commonly known as a jet-ski.
