

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BRCC ROAD RACE)
(VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2019

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2019.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Road Race on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 9th June 2019.
3. The speed limit fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 is varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Road Race.
4. The roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are subject at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

SPEED LIMIT	ROADS	TIMES
75 kilometres per hour	Start/Finish line will be set up near the Flatts Post Office. The race will proceed west and bear left onto Vermont Road, turn left onto St. Mark's Road, turn left and continue east along South Road. The race will turn left onto Paynter's Road and turn right onto Harrington Sound Road. The race will continue around Harrington Sound, through the Swizzle Inn Roundabout onto North Shore Road, and return to the Start / Finish. Cyclists will make a maximum of four laps.	8:00am to 10:30am
