

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BRCC ROAD RACE)  
ORDER 2019

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Road Race) Order 2019.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association BRCC Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 9th June 2019.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

**RACE ROUTE: Start/Finish line will be set up near the Flatts Post Office. The race will proceed west and bear left onto Verdmont Road, turn left onto St. Mark’s Road, turn left and continue east along South Road. The race will turn left onto Paynter’s Road and turn right onto Harrington Sound Road. The race will continue around Harrington Sound, through the Swizzle Inn Roundabout onto North Shore Road, and return to the Start / Finish. Cyclists will make a maximum of four laps.**

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 9th June 2019 at 8:00am and is expected to conclude by 10:30am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROADS CLOSED:** There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

**PARKING:** There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
