

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIP BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2019

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Championship Bicycle Road Race) Order 2019.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Championship Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 30th June 2019.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Start/ Finish at Clearwater Beach parking lot. Travel through the parking lot and onto Coopers Island Road heading north. At the roundabout turn left on Southside Road and then make the left at the junction with Tommy Fox Road. At the roundabout go right up to St. David’s Road and turn left. Stay on St. David’s road and then through the roundabout onto Kindley Field Road and then to the Causeway. Go up Blue Hole Hill to the roundabout and turn back down Blue Hole Hill. Continue back on the Causeway, Kindley Field Road and St. David’s Road. Stay on St. David’s Road to Lighthouse Road, making the immediate right on Texas Road. Then turn right on Tommy Fox Road and left on Pepper Hall Road. At the roundabout then travel along Coopers Island Road to the start/finish.

Big Loop (first lap for Open Male) – Begins same as Main Loop but at the roundabout at Swizzle Inn proceed to North Shore Road and continue to Flatts. Turn left at Harrington Sound Road and continue around Harrington Sound to Wilkinson Avenue up to the roundabout. Rejoin the Main Loop and head back along the course as above.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 30th June 2019 at 8:00am and is expected to conclude by 10:30am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
