

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2019

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bicycle Road Race) Order 2019.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association and VT Construction Madison Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Bermuda Land Development Company Limited roadways in St. George’s Parsh to be held on Sunday, 7th April 2019.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Start/Finish line on Cooper’s Island Road near Clearwater Beach. Contestants will travel north to Southside Road and then travel west along Southside Road to the old number one gate junction with Kindley Field Road roundabout. The contestants will turn just before the roundabout and then travel in an easterly direction along St David’s Road through to the junction of Pepper Hall Hill, then turn right and travel in a southerly direction to Cooper’s Island Road and Southside Road roundabout, then travel in a southerly direction along Cooper’s Island Road to the finish line.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 7th April 2019 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 11:30am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
