

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (SINCLAIR PACKWOOD MEMORIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE)
(NO. 3) ORDER 2019

The Corporation of St. George, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Sinclair Packwood Memorial Bicycle Road Race) (No. 3) Order 2019.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Sinclair Packwood Memorial Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Corporation of St. George roadways to be held on Friday, 24th May 2019.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and Corporation of St. George authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Starting on York Street in St George and heading west towards the City of Hamilton. Continue west along Mullet Bay Road onto the Swing Bridge then onto Kindley Field Road. Follow Kindley Field Road and The Causeway onto North Shore Road to Flatts. Then travel west along Middle Road towards the City of Hamilton onto Cavendish Road then Reid Street. Travel west on Reid Street, then turn left and travel south on Court Street then turn right on Front Street and travel west to Queen Street. Turn right then travel north to Church Street then turn right and travel east on Church Street, then turn left on Cedar Avenue and travel north. Continue north and end the race at the junction of Cedar Avenue and Dundonald Street.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Friday, 24th May 2019 at 8:50am and is expected to conclude by 9:45am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event. No traffic will be allowed to travel in either direction during the bicycle race.

ROADS CLOSED: All roads on the race route will be closed to traffic while this bicycle race takes place. All motorists must also allow cyclists to participate and give way when directed by police and race officials.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
