

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (ST DAVID'S COUNTY CRICKET CLUB BICYCLE RACE, GO KART AND MOTOR GO KART RACE) ORDER 2019

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister responsible for works and engineering by section 7(2A) and (2B) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (St David's County Cricket Club Bicycle Race, Go Kart Race and Motor Go Kart Race) Order 2019.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the St David's County Cricket Club Bicycle Race, Go Kart Race and Motor Go Kart Race to be held on Friday, 19th April 2019.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the St David's County Cricket Club Bicycle Race, Go Kart Race and Motor Go Kart Race.
4. The roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the St David's County Cricket Club Bicycle Race, Go Kart Race and Motor Go Kart Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

SPEED LIMIT	ROADS	TIMES
50 kilometres per hour	Bicycle participants, Go Kart participants and Motor Go Kart participants will commence at Mount Road, St. David's near the turnaround area, then travel in a northerly direction to St. Luke's Lane, turn left onto St. Luke's Lane then travel in a westerly direction to Texas Road, then turn right onto Texas Road and travel in a north-easterly direction to Great Bay Road, then turn right onto Great Bay Road, then travel in an easterly direction along Great Bay Road to the St. David's Cricket Club entrance and end the race.	4:00 pm to 4:45pm
