

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (WORLD TRIATHLON SERIES BERMUDA ROAD CLOSURES) ORDER 2019

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister responsible for works and engineering by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (World Triathlon Series Bermuda Road Closures) Order 2019.
2. The Minister responsible for works and engineering notifies the public that the World Triathlon Series Bermuda will be holding a road race on Saturday, 27th April 2018 between the hours of 7:00am and 6:00pm on various roads in and outside of the City of Hamilton.
3. The bicycle race route is as follows:

**This race will begin by exiting the City of Hamilton via Wesley Street and Park Road to travel west along Serpentine Road to Pitt's Bay Road and then turn left and travel south along Pitt's Bay Road to Woodbourne Avenue, then turn left and travel north along Woodbourne Avenue to Richmond Road, then turn right and travel east along Richmond Road to the City of Hamilton. The race will continue through the City of Hamilton via Church Street, King Street and Reid Street extension and exit via Spurling's Hill onto Crow Lane. The contestants will then travel in an easterly direction along Crow Lane until reaching The Lane, then travel in a westerly direction until reaching Pomander Road, turning right onto Pomander Road and travelling in a westerly direction along Pomander Road to Harbour Road, then turning left and travelling south along Harbour Road to The Lane, then travelling in an easterly direction along The Lane until reaching the roundabout at the junction with Trimingham Road, then travelling south along Trimingham Road until reaching the roundabout at the junction with South Road. The contestants will do a U-turn before reaching the roundabout and then travel in a northerly direction back along Trimingham Road and continue onto Crow Lane until reaching Corkscrew Hill, then travel in a northerly direction uphill along Corkscrew Hill until reaching Middle Road, then turn left and travel west along Middle Road, then continue travelling west along Cavendish Road until reaching the City of Hamilton. The contestants will then travel west on Reid Street extension and Reid Street, then turn left onto Court Street and right onto Front Street and travel to the end location at the junction with Queen Street. This race route will be repeated during this event until such time as contestants have achieved the full length of the race course.**

4. Roads will be closed during this race. Motorists are advised to use caution and alternative routes, giving priority to cyclists. Motorists are also advised to follow directions given by the police and race marshals. The roads affected by the road closures for this race are as follows:

Serpentine Road  
Pitt's Bay Road from Serpentine Road to Bermudiana Road  
Woodbourne Avenue  
Richmond Road  
Spurling's Hill  
Crow Lane  
The Lane  
Pomander Road  
Harbour Road  
Trimingham Road  
Corkscrew Hill  
Middle Road, Devonshire - West of Corkscrew Hill  
Cavendish Road.

5. There will be parking restrictions in place during the bicycle race, and motorists are required to park at alternative sites to assist with the open roadways required for this bicycle race route. When needing access to the resident's property, motorists need to communicate with the police or race marshals to learn the best way to access or depart from their residences.
