MERCHANT SHIPPING (SAFETY OF NAVIGATION) AMENDMENT
REGULATIONS 2020

BR 147 / 2020

The Minister responsible for Maritime Administration, after consulting the persons referred to in section 94(3) of the Merchant Shipping Act 2002, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 87, 93 and 96 of that Act, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Safety of Navigation) Amendment Regulations 2020.

Amends regulation 3

2 Regulation 3(4) of the Merchant Shipping (Safety of Navigation) Regulations 2010 (“the principal Regulations”) is amended by deleting “19” and substituting “19, 19-1”.

Amends regulation 4

3 Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) in paragraph (2)(l) by deleting “.” and substituting “and regulation 34-1.”; and
- (b) in paragraph (4)(a) by deleting “of regulations”.

Amends Schedule 2

4 Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) by inserting the following paragraph next after paragraph 6—

“(6A) If a ship, to which regulation 19-1 applies, proceeds or attempts to proceed on any voyage or excursion without complying with a requirement in

paragraph 4, 5, 6 or 7 of that regulation, the owner and the master each commit an offence, punishable on summary conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and on conviction on indictment, by imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years, or an unlimited fine or both.”; and

(b) in paragraph 20, by deleting “paragraph 3 of regulation 34” and substituting “regulation 34-1”.
