PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) AMENDMENT (NO. 5)  
REGULATIONS 2020

His Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister of Health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2020 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Amendment (No. 5) Regulations 2020.

Amends regulation 5

2 In regulation 5 of the principal Regulations—

(a) in paragraph (3)—

(i) revoke subparagraph (c) and substitute—

“(c) persons while in attendance at—

(i) a service or ceremony held on the premises of a church or other religious establishment, whether indoors or outdoors; or

(ii) a funeral service, or a marriage or domestic partnership ceremony, whether or not held on the premises of a church or other religious establishment;”;

(ii) delete the comma at the end of subparagraph (d) and substitute a semicolon;

(iii) insert after subparagraph (d)—

- (e) persons while in attendance at a school or the Bermuda College;
- (f) persons while participating in the conduct of a parliamentary election,”; and
- (iv) after “appropriate physical distancing is maintained”, insert “and relevant guidance on other precautions to be taken is followed”;
- (b) in paragraph (4)—
  - (i) delete “, after consulting the Minister of Health,”; and
  - (ii) after “appropriate physical distancing is maintained”, insert “and relevant guidance on other precautions to be taken is followed”; and
- (c) insert after paragraph (5)—
  - “(6) In this regulation—
    - “parliamentary election” has the meaning given in section 1(1) of the Parliamentary Election Act 1978;
    - “school” has the meaning given in section 2(1) of the Education Act 1996.”.

Inserts regulation 8B

3 The principal Regulations are amended by inserting after the revoked regulation 8A—

“Restriction on raft-ups

8B No person shall—

- (a) tie together for recreational purposes (raft-up) more than three boats;
- (b) participate in a raft-up that consists of more than three boats; or
- (c) participate in more than one raft-up (of any number of boats) occurring at the same time.”.
