ELECTRICITY (LICENCE THRESHOLD) TEMPORARY AMENDMENT
REGULATIONS 2021

The Minister responsible for energy, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Regulatory Authority Act 2011 and section 54 of the Electricity Act 2016, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which temporarily amend the Electricity (Licence Threshold) Regulations 2018 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Electricity (Licence Threshold) Temporary Amendment Regulations 2021.

Temporary reduction of licence threshold

2 (1) During the period commencing with the publication of these Regulations in the Gazette and ending on 31 May 2021, for the purposes of the definition of “licence threshold” in section 2(1) of the Electricity Act 2016, the installed capacity from which a licence is required for generation is reduced from 500 kilowatts (0.5 megawatts) to 250 kilowatts (0.25 megawatts).

(2) Consequently, during that period, in regulation 4 of the principal Regulations, for “500 kilowatts (0.5 megawatts)” substitute “250 kilowatts (0.25 megawatts)”.
