The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1)(a) and (aa) of the Marine Board Act 1962 and paragraph 4 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 5) Notice 2021.

Jet-ski closed-circuit race

A jet-ski closed-circuit race will be held at Ferry Reach on Sunday 12 September 2021 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Race to be patrolled

- 3 (1) Ferry Reach will be patrolled by marshal boats at the race.
 - (2) All persons attending the race by boat or jet-ski are required to—
 - (a) follow all directions given by marshals; and
 - (b) exercise extreme caution, whether or not directions are given by a marshal.

Non-application of speed limits

The speed limits fixed by paragraph 3 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001 do not apply to persons participating in the race.

Offence

It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 for a person to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 112 of that Act.
