The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1) of the Marine Board Act 1962, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 6) Notice 2021.

Christmas Boat Parade, Hamilton Harbour

2 A Christmas Boat Parade ("the Parade") will be held in Hamilton Harbour on Saturday 18 December 2021 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Closure of certain areas of Hamilton Harbour

3 (1) The area of waters of Hamilton Harbour, on a line between Saltus Island and the eastern end of Hinson's Island to the Warwick shoreline at Godet's Passage, will be closed to normal marine traffic during the Parade.

(2) During the Parade, all boatman are required to observe a five-knot no wake restriction and exercise caution when approaching or navigating the waters of Hamilton Harbour.

Patrol of course

4 During the Parade, the waters of Hamilton Harbour will be patrolled by the Royal Bermuda Regiment coast guard unit.
