The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1)(a) and (b) of the Marine Board Act 1962 and paragraph 4 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) Notice 2021.

Power boat closed-circuit races

2 Power boat closed-circuit races will be held on the following dates at Ferry Reach between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.—

- (a) Sunday 18 April 2021;
- (b) Sunday 9 May 2021;
- (c) Sunday 23 May 2021;
- (d) Sunday 13 June 2021;
- (e) Sunday 27 June 2021;

- (f) Sunday 18 July 2021;
- (g) Sunday 26 September 2021.

Patrol of race

3 Ferry Reach will be patrolled by marshal boats, and all persons approaching the race by boat are required to—

- (a) follow all lawful directions given by marshals during the race; and
- (b) exercise extreme caution, whether or not directions have been given by a marshal.

Non-application of speed limits

4 The speed limits fixed by paragraph 3 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001 do not apply to persons participating in the race.

Offence

5 (1) It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 for persons to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 112 of that Act.

(2) In this Notice “boat” includes a personal water craft, commonly known as a jetski.
