PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (PHASED RE-OPENING)
AMENDMENT (NO. 5) REGULATIONS 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Amendment (No. 5) Regulations 2021.

Inserts regulation 19A

2 The Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Regulations 2021 are amended by inserting after regulation 19 the following—

“Offences to which public health penalty ticket is applicable

19A (1) In accordance with section 107B(7) and Part VA of the Public Health Act 1949, a public health penalty ticket may be issued in respect of such offences under these Regulations as are listed in Schedule 2 to the Public Health (COVID-19) Penalties Regulations 2021, and, to the extent provided in those Regulations, those Regulations shall apply in respect of those offences.

(2) A person to whom a public health penalty ticket under the Public Health (COVID-19) Penalties Regulations 2021 is issued in respect of an offence referred to in paragraph (1), who pays the penalty specified in the ticket in compliance with those Regulations, shall only be liable to pay the penalty as provided in regulation 7(2)(b) of those Regulations.

(3) For the avoidance of doubt, and in accordance with section 107J of the Public Health Act 1949, a person to whom a public health penalty ticket is issued

under the Public Health (COVID-19) Penalties Regulations 2021, as provided under paragraph (1), who fails to pay the penalty specified in the ticket within the period of 28 days or within an extended period of time, as may be granted under section 107I of the Public Health Act 1949, is liable, on conviction of the offence specified in the ticket, to the fines provided in regulation 19(1) or 19(2) of these Regulations.

(4) A public health penalty ticket referred to in this regulation shall be issued by a police officer, as provided under Part VA of the Public Health Act 1949.”.
