PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (PHASED RE-OPENING)  
AMENDMENT (NO. 12) REGULATIONS 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Amendment (No. 12) Regulations 2021.

Inserts regulation 15B

2 The Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-Opening) Regulations 2021 are amended by inserting, after the revoked regulation 15A, the following regulation—

“Utilities, telecommunications etc

15B During the night-time curfew, persons providing the following services are permitted to respond to emergency calls for supply, restoration of service or repairs, provided appropriate physical distancing is maintained at all times—

- (a) utility supply (electricity and domestic gas);
- (b) water truckers;
- (c) telecommunications, computer repair and internet service providers;
- (d) plumbing and electrical repairs;
- (e) repair of large appliances.”.
