PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (PHASED RE-OPENING)
AMENDMENT (NO. 4) REGULATIONS 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Regulations 2021 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Amendment (No. 4) Regulations 2021.

Amends regulation 5

2 In regulation 5 of the principal Regulations, in paragraphs (1), (2), (3)(c)(ii), (3)(c)(iii), (3)(c)(iv), (3)(d)(ii), (3)(d)(iii), (3)(d)(iv), (3)(h) and (5), delete “100 persons” and substitute “50 persons”.

Commencement

3 These Regulations shall come into effect on 1 July 2021.
