PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (PHASED RE-OPENING)  
AMENDMENT (NO. 6) REGULATIONS 2021

BR 136 / 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-Opening) Regulations 2021 (the “principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Amendment (No. 6) Regulations 2021.

Amends regulation 5

2 The principal Regulations are amended by revoking regulation 5(5A) and substituting the following—

“(5A) The Minister of Youth, Culture and Sport shall require that all members of the group possess, and present for verification, their valid SafeKey at the specified place on the specified date or dates.”.

Inserts regulations 6A, 8A, 12A and 17A

3 The principal Regulations are amended by inserting—

(a) after regulation 6, the following—

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“Bars and clubs

6A (1) The owner or operator of a bar or club shall ensure each customer permitted to use the indoor facilities possesses, and presents for verification, a valid SafeKey to the appropriate official in the bar or club.

(2) In this regulation—

“bar” means premises licensed under a Licence (B) (within the meaning of section 9(1)(c) of the Liquor Licence Act 1974);

“club” means premises licensed under a Night Club Licence, Proprietary Club Licence or Members’ Club Licence (within the meaning of paragraph (f), (g) or (h) of section 9(1) of the Liquor Licence Act 1974, respectively).”;

(b) after regulation 8, the following—

“Restaurants

8A The owner or operator of a restaurant shall ensure that each person permitted to dine indoors possesses, and presents for verification, a valid SafeKey to the appropriate official in the restaurant.”;

(c) after regulation 12, the following—

“Gymnasiums, gyms and sports clubs

12A (1) The owner or operator of a gymnasium, gym or sports club shall ensure that each person permitted to use the indoor facilities possesses, and presents for verification, a valid SafeKey to the appropriate official in the gymnasium, gym or sports club.

(2) The reference in paragraph (1) to “the owner or operator of a gymnasium, gym or sports club” shall, where such gymnasium, gym or sports club has been leased to another person, refer to the person to whom the gymnasium, gym or sports club has been leased.”;

(d) after regulation 17, the following—

“Island boats

17A (1) The owner or operator of an Island boat that is to accommodate more than 20 people shall ensure that each person permitted on the boat possesses, and presents for verification, a valid SafeKey to the appropriate official on the boat.

(2) In this regulation, “Island boat” has the meaning given under regulation 1 of the Marine Board (Island Boats) Regulations 1965.”.

Commencement

4 These Regulations shall come into operation at 6 p.m. on 20 August 2021.
