PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19) PENALTIES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2021

BR 144 / 2021

The Minister responsible for health, in exercise of the power conferred by section 107K of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19) Penalties Amendment Regulations 2021.

Amends Schedule 2

2 Schedule 2 Part 2 of the Public Health (COVID-19) Penalties Regulations 2021 is amended by inserting the following in numeric order—

| regulation 3A   | Failure of person to comply with the requirement to remain in his home or accommodation during the night-time curfew.   |
| regulation 17A  | Failure of owner or operator of an Island boat that is to accommodate more than 20 persons to ensure that the persons on the boat possess a valid SafeKey.  |
| regulation 17AA | (1) Failure of owner or operator of a boat to comply with the maximum number of persons who may use the boat.<br>(2) Failure of owner or operator of a boat to comply with the requirements of regulation 17AA(2) while remaining on a boat during the night-time curfew.<br>(3) Breach of prohibition to tie a boat to another boat (raft-up) for recreational purposes. |
