QUARANTINE (COVID-19) (NO. 3) AMENDMENT (NO. 7) ORDER 2021

The Minister responsible for health, in exercise of the power conferred by section 9 of the Quarantine Act 2017, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This Order may be cited as the Quarantine (COVID-19) (No. 3) Amendment (No. 7) Order 2021.

Amends paragraph 6AA

2 Paragraph 6AA(1) of the Quarantine (COVID-19) (No. 3) Order 2020 is revoked and replaced as follows—

“(1) Each person who is vaccinated and who intends to travel to, and be landed in, Bermuda under Part 4 of this Order may be required, as may be determined by the Quarantine Authority in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer, to undergo a COVID-19 test, which test may be either a—

- (a) COVID-19 PCR test under paragraph 6; or
- (b) COVID-19 antigen test under this paragraph, which must be taken not more than three days before arrival in Bermuda.”.
