MARINE BOARD (CONTROL OVER MARITIME TRAFFIC) (NO. 6) NOTICE 2022

The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(1)(aa) of the Marine Board Act 1962, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 6) Notice 2022.

Interpretation

2 In this Notice, "boatman" includes a person who operates a personal water craft (commonly referred to as a jet ski).

World Triathlon Series swim races

3 The World Triathlon Series swim races will take place within Hamilton Harbour on Saturday 5 November 2022 and Sunday 6 November 2022.

Closure of section of Hamilton Harbour

4 (1) The section of Hamilton Harbour between the east face of Albuoy's Point and mid-way of Hamilton 7 berth will be closed to normal marine traffic during the following times—

- (a) Saturday 5 November 2022 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.;
 - (b) Sunday 6 November 2022 between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- (2) The section referred to in subparagraph (1) will be patrolled by marshal boats.

Mariners to exercise caution

5 All mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to keep clear of the section referred to in paragraph 4 and exercise caution when approaching the area.

Offence

6 It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 112 of that Act.
