MOTOR CAR (DRIVERS' LICENCES) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2022

BR 81 / 2022

The Minister responsible for transport, in exercise of the power conferred by section 96 of the Motor Car Act 1951, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Motor Car (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1952, may be cited as the Motor Car (Drivers' Licences) Amendment Regulations 2022.

Amends Motor Car (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1952

2 The Motor Car (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1952 are amended in regulation 6—

- (a) in paragraph (a), by deleting "one month" and substituting "of two weeks";
- (b) in paragraph (b), by deleting "three months" and substituting "one month";
- (c) in paragraph (c), by deleting "six months" and substituting "three months".

Commencement and application

3 (1) These Regulations come into operation on 18 July 2022 and apply in respect of a person who fails a test of competence to drive on or after that date.

(2) Accordingly, and for the avoidance of doubt, a person who failed a test of competence to drive before 18 July 2022 shall not be eligible to take another test of competence to drive for—

- (a) a period of one month after failing the first test;
- (b) a period of three months after failing the second test; or
- (c) a period of six months after failing the third or subsequent test.
