PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19) EMERGENCY EXTENSION (NO. 4) ORDER 2022

BR 59 / 2022

WHEREAS the Public Health (COVID-19) Emergency Order 2021 declared a public health emergency with effect from 6am on 25 January 2021;

AND WHEREAS that Order has been extended and, unless further extended, will cease to have effect at 6am on 30 May 2022;

AND WHEREAS the Minister responsible for health, after consultation with the Chief Medical Officer, has determined that it is necessary to further extend that Order;

NOW THEREFORE the Minister responsible for health, in exercise of the power conferred by section 107A of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This Order may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19) Emergency Extension (No. 4) Order 2022.

Extension of Public Health (COVID-19) Emergency Order 2021

2 (1) The Public Health (COVID-19) Emergency Order 2021 is extended for 60 days.

(2) Accordingly, in paragraph 3(2) of that Order, delete "30 May 2022" and substitute "29 July 2022".
