The Minister responsible for health, in exercise of the power conferred by section 107K of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19) Penalties Regulations 2021 (the “principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19) Penalties Amendment (No. 5) Regulations 2022.

Amends Regulation 3

2 Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (b), by deleting “regulation 4 of the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2022” and substituting “regulation 4 of the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 2) Regulations 2022”.

Amends Regulation 4

3 Regulation 4(2) of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (b) by deleting “Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2022” and substituting “Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 2) Regulations 2022”.

Amends Regulation 7

4 Regulation 7(2) of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting “Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2022” wherever it appears and substituting “Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 2) Regulations 2022”.

Amends Schedule 2

5 Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations is amended by deleting “Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2022” wherever it appears and substituting “Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 2) Regulations 2022”.

Commencement

6 These Regulations shall come into effect at 6am on 3 October 2022.
