

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

**ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BERMUDA CYCLING
ACADEMY BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2022**

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Cycling Academy Bicycle Road Race) Order 2022.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bermuda Cycling Academy Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on the roadways in Sandys Parish to be held on Sunday, 2nd October 2022.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Commencing at Free Port Drive and traveling in a westerly direction towards Cockburn Road, and then travel in a westerly direction to Malabar Road, then travel in a westerly direction along Malabar Road to Watford Bridge, then travel in a westerly direction along Mangrove Bay Road, then travel in a westerly direction along Mangrove Bay Road to Somerset Road, then travel in a westerly direction to Cambridge Road and turn right on Cambridge Road then travel in a northerly direction along Cambridge Road to the junction with Mangrove Bay Road, then turn right and travel in an easterly direction along Mangrove Bay Road to Somerset Village then travel in an easterly direction along Mangrove Bay Road to Watford Bridge, then travel in easterly direction along Malabar Road to Cockburn Road and then travel in an easterly direction to Pender Road and to the entrance of Dockyard then turn right on to Free Port Drive and then travel in westerly direction along Free Port Drive where the race will end.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 2nd October 2022 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 10:00am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
