

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION NATIONAL TIME TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2022

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association National Time Trial Championship Bicycle Road Race) Order 2022.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association National Time Trial Championship Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Bermuda Land Development Company Limited roadways in St. George’s Parish to be held on Sunday, 19th June 2022.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

**RACE ROUTE: Starting on Cooper’s Island Road head north along Cooper’s Island Road to the roundabout, then turn left onto Southside Road, travel west along Southside Road to the Westcott Road roundabout, turn right and travel in an easterly direction along Southside Road towards Tommy Fox Road, travel in an easterly direction onto Pepper Hall Road, turn right and travel in a southerly direction towards Cooper’s Island Road roundabout, and repeat this lap as necessary, then travel in a southerly direction along Cooper’s Island Road to the finish line.**

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 19th June 2022 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 10:00am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROADS CLOSED:** There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

**PARKING:** There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
