

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION WORKS TIME TRIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2022

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Works Time Trial Bicycle Road Race) Order 2022.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Works Time Trial Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 29th May 2022.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Commencing at Kindley Field Road and travel in easterly direction to the Swing Bridge Roundabout, then travel in easterly direction along St David’s Road towards Cashew City Road turn around then head in a westerly direction along St David’s Road to Swing Bridge Roundabout, then travel in westerly direction along Kindley Field Road to the Airport Roundabout and the Causeway, then travel in westerly direction along The Causeway to North Shore Road and to the Wilkinson Avenue Roundabout junction, then turn at the roundabout and then travel in easterly direction along North Shore Road to The Causeway then travel in easterly direction along The Causeway to the Airport Roundabout, then end the race at Kindley Field Road.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 29th May 2022 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 11:00am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
