

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (LIBERTY MUTUAL TRIATHLON) ORDER 2022

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Liberty Mutual Triathlon) Order 2022.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Liberty Mutual Triathlon (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 12th June 2022.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Commencing on Front Street and traveling west along Pitt’s Bay Road to Woodbourne Avenue, then turn right and travel north along Woodbourne Avenue to Gorham Road then turn right and travel east along Gorham Road to Bermudiana Road and then turn right and travel south along Bermudiana Road to Front Street, then turn left on Front Street, and travel in an easterly direction along Crow Lane to the Crow Lane roundabout then turn right at the roundabout then head in a westerly direction along Crow Lane onto Front Street and head to end of race route.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 12th June 2022 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 11:00am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
