The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 65 of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Marine and Ports (Seaborne Services) Regulations 2023.

Interpretation

2 In these Regulations, “Seaborne Services” means services performed by the Minister under section 65 of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021.

Rate of Dues

3 Dues payable in respect of Seaborne Services shall be calculated as set out in the Schedule.

Revocation

4 The Marine Board (Seaborne Services) Regulations 2021 are revoked.

Commencement

5 These Regulations shall come into force on 1 April 2023.

TUGS**

Berthing or Unberthing	\$1,531 per movement
Tug boat hourly rate	\$931 per hour per tug

**PART 3
TENDER SERVICE**

Per round trip to cruise vessels (Dockyard)	\$1,475
Per round trip to cruise vessels (at anchor)	\$1,531
Charter	\$970 per hour, subject to a minimum of four hours

VESSEL SERVICES FOR OFFSHORE TOWAGE, SALVAGE OR CHARTER**

Tug	\$1,537 per hour

Notes

- 1 Tender Service to cruise vessels is subject to a minimum of—
 - (a) three round trips for the first 12 hour period; and
 - (b) five round trips in any 24 hour period.
- 2 Except in the case of dues specified in Part 4 of the Schedule, all charges are subject to a 100 per cent surcharge—
 - (a) on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays; and
 - (b) between 4:30pm and 8:00am on normal working days.
