

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION NATIONAL ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2023

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association National Road Race Championship Bicycle Road Race) Order 2023.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association National Road Race Championship Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Sunday, 18th June 2023.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Commencing on Middle Road by Whitney Institute School proceeding in a westerly direction towards Verdmont Road, then left onto St. Mark’s Road, then left onto South Road towards Paynter’s Road. Turn left onto Paynter’s Road and right onto Harrington Sound Road travelling east. Proceed up Wilkinson Avenue towards the Blue Hole Hill roundabout and head west on North Shore Road towards Flatts Village, then stay left at the junction heading up Middle Road back to Whitney Institute School. There will be multiple races along this route and up to six laps performed.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 18th June 2023 at 7:15am and is expected to conclude by 11:00am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
