

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (SINCLAIR PACKWOOD MEMORIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE)
ORDER 2023

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Sinclair Packwood Memorial Bicycle Road Race) Order 2023.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Sinclair Packwood Memorial Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works, Corporation of Hamilton and Corporation of St. George roadways to be held on Friday, 26th May 2023.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: Starting on York Street in St. George’s and heading west towards Ferry Reach on Mullet Bay Road. Continue west along Mullet Bay Road onto the Swing Bridge then onto Kindley Field Road. Travel in a westerly direction along Kindley Field Road to The Causeway, then merge onto North Shore Road to head into Flatt’s. Then heading up Flatt’s Hill to merge onto Middle Road to continue west towards the City of Hamilton. Travel along Cavendish Road onto Reid Street. Continue west on Reid Street, to turn left onto Court Street then right onto Front Street heading west. From Front Street turn right onto Queen Street going north. Then turn right onto Church Street to head east, then turn left onto Cedar Avenue and travel north. Continue north onto Marsh Folly Road, then right onto Dutton Avenue and finishing at Bernard’s Park.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Friday, 26th May 2023 at 8:20am and is expected to conclude by 9:45am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event. No traffic will be allowed to travel in either direction during the bicycle race.

ROADS CLOSED: All roads on the race route will be closed to traffic while this bicycle race takes place. All motorists must also allow cyclists to participate and give way when directed by police and race officials.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
