#### SCHEDULE

[made under section 13 of the Bermuda Monetary Authority Act 1969 [title 16 item 11] and brought into operation on 7 August 1998]

#### Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Bermuda Monetary Authority (Triangular Coins) Regulations 1998.

### Interpretation

2 In these Regulations—

"the Authority" means the Bermuda Monetary Authority;

"the Minister" means the Minister of Finance;

"the 1998 Triangular Coins" means the coins issued in 1998 by the Authority under regulation 3.

#### Issue of the 1998 Triangular Coins

The Authority may, in 1998, issue the 1998 Triangular Coins.

# BERMUDA MONETARY AUTHORITY (1998 TRIANGULAR COINS) REGULATIONS 1998

#### **Denominations**

4 The denominations of the 1998 Triangular Coins shall be as follows, that is to say—

\$1 (one dollar); \$3 (three dollars); \$30 (thirty dollars); \$60 (sixty dollars) \$180 (one hundred and eighty dollars).

#### Form and Design

- 5 The form and design of the 1998 Triangular Coins shall be in accordance with the sample coins deposited with the Authority in particular—
  - (a) the obverse design of the coin shall be the portrait by sculptor Raphael Maklouf of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II in profile wearing the royal crown, surrounded by a single rope border, together with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" and "1998", and the denominational value of each coin shall appear on the perimeter thereof;
  - (b) the reverse design of the coin shall feature the Deliverance in full sail superimposed on a map of the northern Atlantic Ocean, surrounded by a single rope border with a knot in each corner, with the inscription "BERMUDA" on the lower perimeter.

# Standard weight and composition

6 The standard weight and composition of the 1998 Triangular Coin, and the amount of tolerance and variation allowed therein shall be as set forth in the Schedule.
