

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BICYCLE ROAD RACE)
(NO. 2) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Bicycle Road Race) (No. 2) Order 2024.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works roads to be held on Monday, 2nd September 2024.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: The bicycle race commences and concludes at the Clearwater Beach carpark. The participants exit the carpark and proceed north along Cooper’s Island Road until reaching the roundabout, then head west onto Southside Road and proceed to the roundabout. The participants traverse around the roundabout, making a U Turn to return to Southside Road, then continue east along Southside Road and then turn left onto Tommy Fox Road, then turn right onto Pepper Hall Road, proceed to the roundabout where they exit onto Cooper’s Island Road and head south to the Clearwater Beach carpark. The participants traverse the above route for all race laps until concluding at the Clearwater carpark.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Monday, 2nd September 2024 at 8:00am and is expected to conclude by 10:30am. All motorists are required to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
