

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION JEN AND FRIENDS TIME TRIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Jen and Friends Time Trial Bicycle Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2024.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Jen and Friends Time Trial Bicycle Road Race on Ministry of Public Works Roads to be held on Sunday, 13th October 2024.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Jen and Friends Time Trial Bicycle Road Race.
4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Jen and Friends Time Trial Bicycle Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

The participants proceed east along North Shore Road, traverse around the Blue Hole Hill Roundabout in Hamilton Parish, and proceed back to the finish line using the same route.</p> <p>The Short Course commences and concludes at the bus layby located to the west of the entrance to Government House on North Shore Road in Pembroke Parish. The participants proceed east along North Shore Road, traverse around the Barkers Hill Roundabout in Devonshire Parish and proceed back to the finish line using the same route.</p>	7:30am to 9:00am
