

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION VT CONSTRUCTION TEAM  
TIME TRIAL BICYCLE ROAD RACE) ORDER 2025

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association VT Construction Team Trial Bicycle Road Race) Order 2025.
2. This Order applies in respect of Bermuda Bicycle Association VT Construction Team Trial Bicycle Road Race (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works and Environment Roads to be held on Sunday, 16th March 2025.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

**RACE ROUTE:** The bicycle race commences and concludes at the Clearwater carpark. The participants proceed north along Cooper’s Island Road until reaching the roundabout and take the first exit on to Southside Road. Then proceed along Southside Road, traverse the roundabout, and take the third exit on to Lower Gates Road. The participants turn left on to St. David’s Road and continue to the Swing Bridge roundabout, then exit on to Kindley Field Road, and proceed to the Airport roundabout, and exit on to The Causeway, then traverse Blue Hole Hill and make a U-Turn at the Blue Hole Hill roundabout. The participants continue on to The Causeway to the Airport Roundabout, where they exit on to Kindley Field Road. Then head to the Swing Bridge Roundabout, exit on to St. David’s Road, and continue until turning right on to Pepper Hall Road. They turn right onto Tommy Fox Road, left onto Pepper Hall Road and head to the roundabout. At the roundabout, the participants exit onto Cooper’s Island Road and head to the finish line at the Clearwater carpark.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 16th March 2025 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 9:00am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROADS CLOSED:** There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

**PARKING:** There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
