ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA TRIATHLON ASSOCIATION AND BERMUDA SPORTS
LAB NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP STANDARD DISTANCE TRIATHLON)
ORDER 2025

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Triathlon Association and Bermuda Sports Lab National Championship Standard Distance Triathlon) Order 2025.
2. This Order applies in respect of Bermuda Triathlon Association and Bermuda Sports Lab National Championship Standard Distance Triathlon (the “bicycle race”) on Ministry of Public Works and Environment Roads to be held on Sunday, 27th April 2025.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

RACE ROUTE: The race commences and concludes at the Triathlon Shed on Clearwater Beach. The participants proceed north along Cooper’s Island Road. At the roundabout of Cooper’s Island Road, Pepper Hall Road and Southside Road take the second exit (i.e. straight) then travel in northerly direction along Pepper Hall Road, crossing Tommy Fox Road and continuing in a northerly direction to St David’s Road. At St David’s Road take a left turn and remain on St David’s Road travelling in a westerly direction until the roundabout with Kindley Field Road and St George’s swing bridge. At the roundabout take the second exit along Kindley Field Road in a westerly direction. A traffic cone will be placed in the middle of Kindley Field Road before the Airport Roundabout where the road is widest due to a parking layby. Cyclists will perform a ‘U’ Turn around the cone on Kindley Field Road before the Airport roundabout and return the way they came to complete lap one (1) of three (3).

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 27th April 2025 at 8:00am and is expected to conclude by 9:45am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

PARKING: There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
