The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 12(1)(b) of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine and Ports Services (Mariners) (PGA Tour Drone Show) Notice 2024.

Interpretation

2 In this Notice, “boat” includes a personal water craft and “boatman” includes a person who operates a personal water craft (commonly referred to as a jet ski).

PGA Tour drone show

3 A PGA Tour drone show (“the event”) will take place in Hamilton Harbour on Wednesday 13 November 2024 between the hours of 8:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.

Closure of area of Hamilton Harbour

- 4 The area of water of Hamilton Harbour (indicated in the Schedule), between—
- (a) the Hamilton Princess Marina east pier face out to approximately 300 feet; and
 - (b) the Hamilton Princess Marina south pier face out to approximately 280 feet,

will be closed to marine traffic during the event.

Patrol of area

5 During the event, the area of water referred to in paragraph 4 will be patrolled by marshal boats and all mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to exercise caution when approaching or navigating the waters of Hamilton Harbour.

Offence

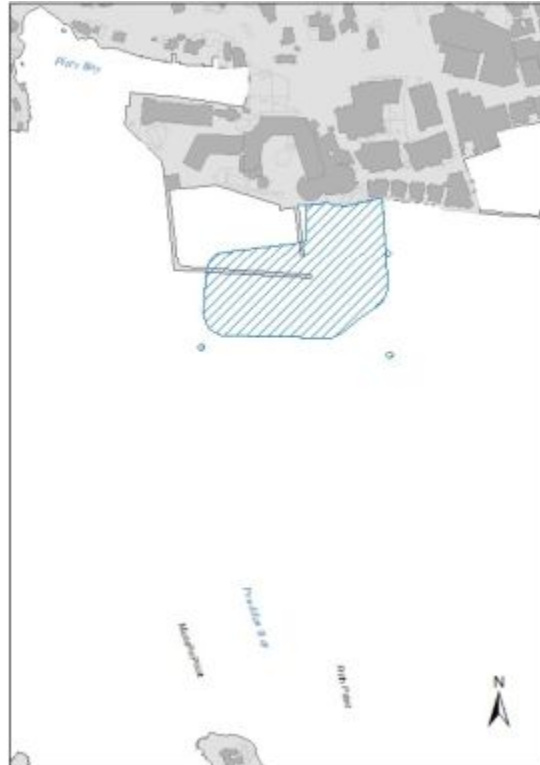
6 It is an offence under section 12(5) of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021 for a mariner, pilot or boatman to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 84 of that Act.
