The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 12(1)(a) and (b) of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021, gives the following Notice:

Citation

9

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine and Ports Services (Mariners) (No. 7) Notice 2023.

Interpretation

In this Notice, "boat" includes a personal watercraft and "boatman" includes a person who operates a personal water craft (commonly referred to as a jet-ski).

Round-the-Island Boat Race

Offence

3 The Round-the-Island Boat Race (the "Race") will take place on Sunday 13 August 2023 from 12:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Course of the Race

The course of the Race will be from Ferry Reach along North Shore to Hog Fish Beacon; to Two Rock Passage and into Hamilton Harbour; around White's Island and through Salt Kettle Bay into Granaway Deep; around Five Star Island and through Port Royal Bay in the Great Sound to Commissioner's Point; past Daniel's Head and along South Shore into St. David's Head; around St. Catherine's Point and past the Oil Docks on the North Shore, before re-entering Ferry Reach to finish.

Closure of certain sea passages etc.

5 (1) On the day of the Race, the following sea passages will be closed to normal marine traffic during the following times—

<u>Sea Passages</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
(a) the passage between the pylons at the entrance to Ferry Reach:	11:45 a.m.	3:30 p.m. or until opened by the coast guard unit
(b) the passage between Hinson's Island and the Paget shoreline:	12:15 p.m.	2:45 p.m. or until opened by the coast guard unit
(c) the passage between Five Star Island and the Southampton mainland:	12:15 p.m.	2:45 p.m. or until opened by the coast guard unit

(2) On the day of the Race, the following areas will be closed to normal marine traffic during the following times—

<u>The Areas</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
(a) the area within 100 metres of the shoreline between Wreck Hill and Pompano:	2:15 p.m.	3:00 p.m. or until opened by the coast guard unit
(b) the area within 100 metres of the shoreline between Castle Roads and St. Davids Head:	2:30 p.m	3:30 p.m. or until opened by the coast guard unit

Race course to be patrolled

- 6 (1) The Race course will be patrolled by the Royal Bermuda Regiment coast guard unit and marshal boats.
- (2) For the duration of the Race, all mariners, pilots and boatmen must exercise extreme caution when navigating within the vicinity of the Race course, particularly in the vicinity of Ferry Reach, Two Rock Passage and White's Island in Hamilton Harbour.

Speed limits not to apply

The speed limits fixed by the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001 do not apply to boats participating in the Race.

Postponement of Race

8 In the event of inclement weather, the Race will take place on either Sunday 20 August 2023 or Sunday 27 August 2023 from 12:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., and the provisions of this Notice apply in all respects to the Race held on either of those dates.

Offence

9 It is an offence under section 12(5) of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021 for a mariner, pilot or boatman to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 84 of that Act.
