ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA TRIATHLON ASSOCIATION STANDARD DISTANCE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TRIATHLON) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Triathlon Association Standard Distance National Championship Triathlon) Order 2024.
2. This Order applies in respect of the Bermuda Triathlon Association Standard Distance National Championship Triathlon (the “bicycle race”) on Bermuda Land Management Corporation roadways in St. David’s and Ministry of Public Works Roads to be held on Sunday, 6th October 2024.
3. The bicycle race will follow the route specified below.
4. The Commissioner of Police is hereby authorized to close roads or portions of roads and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides in the interests of public safety.

**RACE ROUTE: The triathlon commences and concludes at the carpark opposite Clearwater Beach. The participants proceed north along Cooper’s Island Road until reaching the roundabout. Then head west onto Southside Road and proceed to the turnaround in the vicinity of Carter House. The participants traverse around the turn to continue east along Southside Road and proceed to the second roundabout where they exit onto Cooper’s Island Road and head south to the finish line.**

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The bicycle race will commence on Sunday, 6th October 2024 at 7:30am and is expected to conclude by 9:30am. All motorists are expected to use caution and to avoid collision with race participants. The race route will be under the control of the police and race officials. Motorists must follow instructions from race officials to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROADS CLOSED:** There will be no roads closed to traffic while the bicycle race takes place.

**PARKING:** There will be no parking restrictions in place for the bicycle race, with motorists permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally, motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.
