

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA BICYCLE ASSOCIATION BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Bicycle Association Bicycle Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2024.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bicycle Road Race on Ministry of Public Works Roads to be held on Sunday, 7th July 2024.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bicycle Road Race.
4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Bicycle Association Bicycle Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

SPEED LIMIT	ROADS	TIMES
75 kilometres per hour	The bicycle race commences and concludes at the Prospect Police Headquarters on Fort Hill Road. The participants exit the compound, turn left and proceed along Fort Hill Road then turn left on to Middle Road and continue until the intersection of Middle Road and North Shore Road. Then proceed west along North Shore Road then turn left on to Blackwatch Pass and then left on to Marsh Folly Road. Continue along Palmetto Road to the roundabout and exit on to Frog Lane. Then exit on to BFA Way then turn right on to Headquarters Hill and proceed to the finish line at the Prospect Police Headquarters.	8:00am to 10:30am
