The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 12(1)(a) and (b) of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021, gives the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine and Ports Services (Mariners) (No. 4) Notice 2023.

Power boat closed circuit races

2 Power boat closed circuit races will take place within the waters of Hamilton Harbour on Sunday 2 July 2023.

Closure of certain areas

3 The areas specified below will be closed to normal marine traffic during the races between the times specified —

MARINE AND PORTS SERVICES (MARINERS) (NO. 4) NOTICE 2023

- (a) the areas between No. 1 Dock and No. 7 Dock out to a distance of approximately 500 feet (as shown in Schedule 1), from 12:00 p.m to 1:00 p.m; and
- (b) the areas between No. 7 Dock to Saltus Island to Reid Island to Doctors Island to White's Island and back to No. 7 Dock (as shown in Schedule 2), from 1:00 p.m to 3:00 p.m.

Patrol of course

4 The areas referred to in this Notice will be patrolled by the marshal boats during the races and all mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to exercise extreme caution when approaching or in areas, and to observe a five knot no wake zone.

Postponement of race

5 In the event that, due to inclement weather, the race is postponed until Sunday 9 July 2023 and the provision of this Notice shall in all respects apply to the race held on that date.

Speed limits not to apply

6 The speed limits fixed by the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001 shall not apply to persons and boats participating in the power boat closed circuit races.

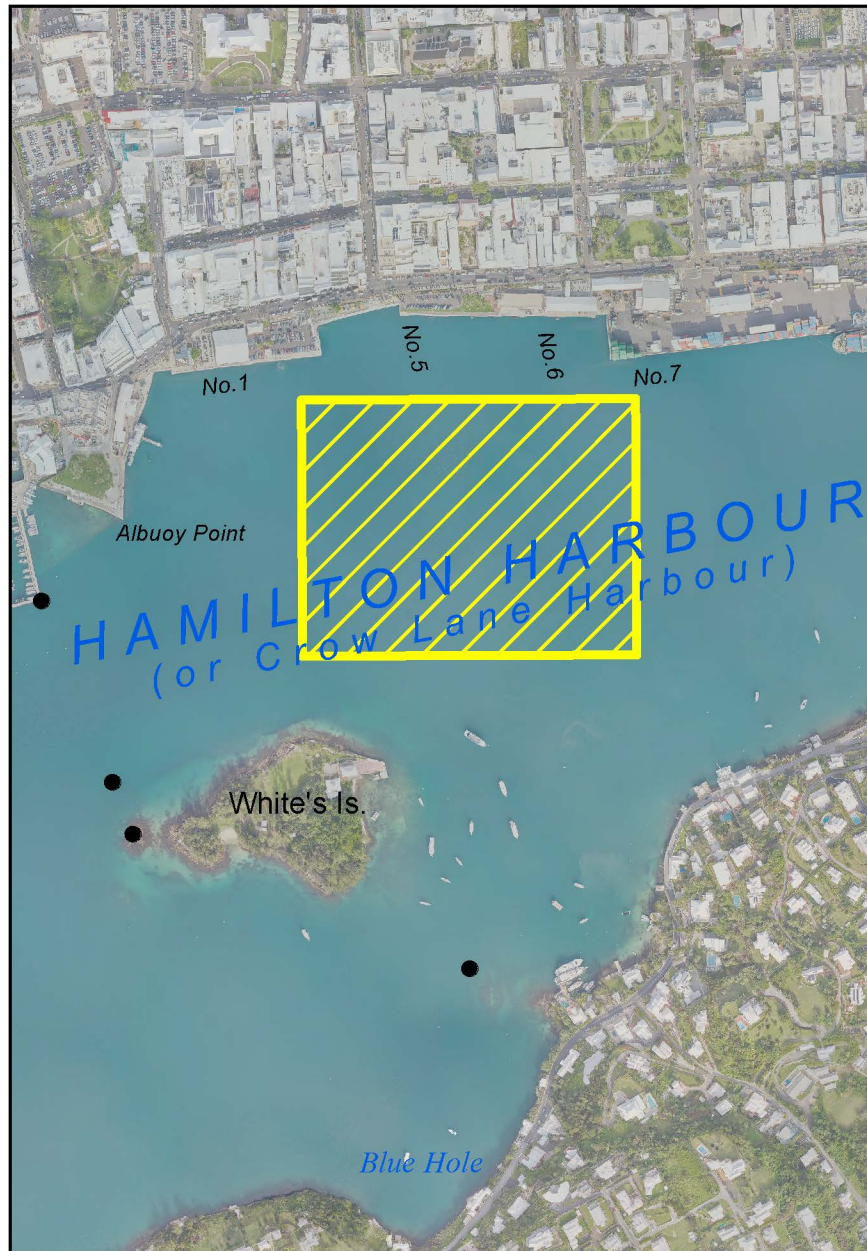
Offence

7 It is an offence under section 12(5) of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021 for a mariner, pilot or boatmen to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice, punishable on summary conviction in accordance with section 84 of that Act.

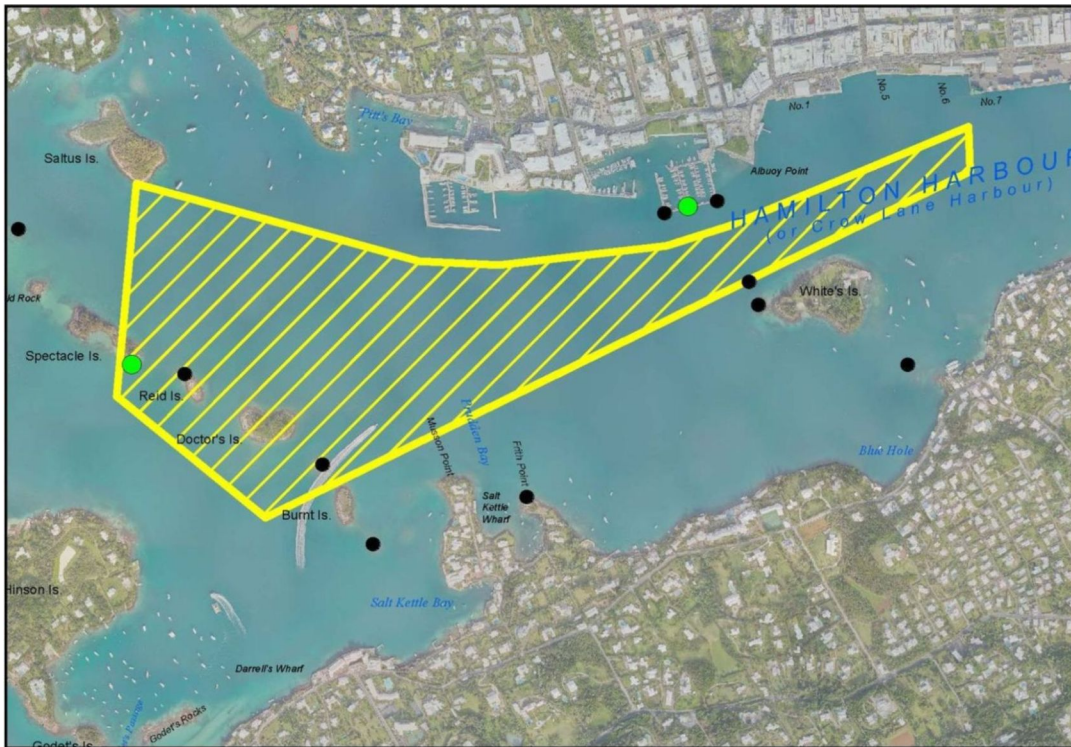
