

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (BERMUDA TRIATHLON ASSOCIATION LIBERTY TRIATHLON BICYCLE ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2024

The Minister responsible for works and engineering, in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bermuda Triathlon Association Liberty Triathlon Bicycle Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2024.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Triathlon Association Liberty Triathlon Bicycle Road Race on Bermuda Land Development Company Limited roadways in St. David's and Ministry of Public Works Roads to be held on Sunday, 30th June 2024.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Triathlon Association Liberty Triathlon Bicycle Road Race.
4. The relevant roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the vehicles attendant on the contestants in the Bermuda Triathlon Association Liberty Triathlon Bicycle Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

SPEED LIMIT	ROADS	TIMES
75 kilometres per hour	The triathlon commences and concludes at the carpark opposite Clearwater Beach. The participants proceed north along Cooper's Island Road until reaching the roundabout. Then head west on to Southside Road and proceed to White's roundabout. The participants traverse around the roundabout, making a U Turn to return to Southside Road. They continue east along Southside Road, proceed to the roundabout where they exit onto Cooper's Island Road and head south to the finish line.	8:00am to 10:00am
