The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 12(1)(a) and (b) of the Marine and Ports Services Act 2021, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine and Ports Services (Mariners) (No. 4) Notice 2024.

Christmas Boat Parade, Hamilton Harbour

The Christmas Boat Parade ("the Parade") will take place in Hamilton Harbour on Saturday, 7 December 2024 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.

Closure of area of Hamilton Harbour

- 3 (1) The area of water of Hamilton Harbour (indicated in the Schedule), on a line between Saltus Island and the eastern end of Hinson's Island to the Warwick shoreline at Godet's Passage, will be closed to normal marine traffic during the Parade.
- (2) During the Parade, all mariners, pilots and boatmen are required to observe a five-knot no wake restriction and exercise caution when approaching or navigating the waters of Hamilton Harbour.

Patrol of course

4 During the Parade, the area of water referred to in paragraph 3 will be patrolled by the Royal Bermuda Regiment coast guard unit.

Postponement of Parade

5 In the event of inclement weather, the Parade will take place on Sunday, 8 December 2024 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m., and the provisions of this Notice will apply in all respects on that date.


Offence
